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# Enhancing ambition successively: roles, drivers, and institutional arrangement (draft)

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### The Paris Agreement

#### Article 4, related to NDC

- ...Each party's successive nationally determined contribution will represent a progression beyond the Party's then current nationally determined contribution and reflect its highest possible ambition, reflecting its CBDR&RC, in the light of different national circumestances...
- In communicating their nationally determined contributions, all Parties shall provide the information necessary for clarity, transparency, and understanding..
- 3. Each parties shall communicate nationally determined contribution every five years...
- 4. All Parties should strive to formulate and communicate long-term low GHG emission development strategies...

## Roles of continuously enhancing ambition

- Draw stakeholders' attention and set up a shared value and vision
- Squeeze out the enhancing potential derived from negotiation and the changes in market and technologies
- Send clear message to investors and practitioners for their decision making
- Ensure progresses in implementing int'l and nat'l policies
- Help speeding up restructuring economies and development of new climate friendly sectors
- Bridging gap based on scientific perspectives

### Drivers to determine enhancing ambition

- Latest scientific findings and corresponding education, communication, and awareness improvement
- Real technological changes: cost and applicability, learning curve, dissemination rate
- Change of price, demand, and supply in market
- Stage of development: income level, structure, sources of growth and development strategies

### Institutional arrangement in continuous ambition enhancement

- Principle:
  - encouraging;
  - balanced and comprehensive and inclusive, broad linkage with other policy metrix
  - Who do what?
- Objectives
- Elements
- Process of decision making
- Process of complying with the institutional arrangement (per int'l cooperation via link of, e.g., carbon market, lowing abatement cost)

#### Outstanding issues

- Ambition (matrix, level, timing, and comparability...)
- Equity (sharing approach, ...)
- Incentives: Means of implementation how to arrange? How to achieve?
- Transparency
- Hesitate to commit high ambition with nobacksliding principle (negative effect of backsliding)
- Linkages between issues/agenda items

## Institutional arrangement in continuous ambition enhancement

- Value, knowledge and information sharing and diffusion and communication mechanism
- Stakeholders identification: their roles, behaviors, and participation
  - Country parties, FCCC
  - Multinational enterprises, incl. financers
  - Sub-national: cities, communities
  - Media, civil society
  - Academic, think tank, developers,
- Interest analysis: powers, rights, and interest identification
- Design and consult deals to reflect concerns and dynamic interests of all stakeholders: define responsibility, rights, and interests (for incentives)
